2020 Chablis Grand Cru “Les Clos”

An extremely graceful Grand Cru Chablis with a wide spectrum of pear, yellow-apple, citrus and mirabelle aromas; Concentrated and refined with excellent precision at the very long, mineral finish that's simultaneously delicate and stony. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis 1er Cru “Montée de Tonnerre”

At first there's a touch of butterscotch, but then the ripe-citrus and yellow-apple aromas comes through on the nose. Concentrated and very focused palate, which has a wonderful integration of fruit, minerality and fine tannin right through the long finish. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis 1er Cru “Mont De Milieu”

This 2020 Chablis Premier Cru is not alone in having some exotic-floral aromas (think hibiscus) and quite a rich texture on the palate, but the special, chalky minerality of this appellation easily balances the ripe orange and melon fruit on the medium-bodied palate. Emphatically dry finish. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis Grand Cru “Preuses”

The stunning nose of ripe orange and apricot, without any hint of opulence, pulls you into this concentrated and beautifully balanced Chablis Grand Cru. Just a touch of oak. The mineral acidity gives this so much energy and brightness. Very long finish with the noble austerity that makes us love these wines. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis 1er Cru “Beuroy”

I love the subtle nose of grapefruit and melted butter. Impressive combination of creamy concentration, candied citrus fruit and healthy acidity on the generous palate. Then comes the long, chalky finish that's wrapped in melted-butter character. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis 1er Cru “Vaillons”

This ripe yet bright Chablis Premier Cru has white-peach and tropical-flower aromas that aren't exactly classic, but very attractive. Lovely balance of mineral acidity with ripe pear and citrusy fruit. A slug of tannin at the finish, but they're fine and add backbone. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis 1er Cru “Fourchaume”

This Premier Cru Chablis has an exciting balance of ripe citrus fruit with vibrant mineral freshness that makes it leap and bound over the palate. Not a hint of the opulence that 2020 sometimes has. Very clean, long finish with complex chalky character. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis 1er Cru “Côte de Léchet”

A very classic Premier Cru Chablis with the chalky austerity we expect from these wines. Excellent depth of candied citrus-peel and wild-herb flavors, the minerality underlined by fine tannins at the impressively long finish. Drink or hold.

2020 Chablis “D1840”

The bright pear and white-peach aromas are complemented by lovely citrusy freshness that makes this medium-bodied, regular Chablis appealing and refreshing. Made entirely from estate-grown fruit. Everything fits very neatly, including just a hint of wood. Drink now.
