Simonnet-Febvre Crémant de Bourgogne Brut

Another New Year's Eve-worthy crémant comes from Simonnet-Febvre out of Chablis. Owned by Maison Louis Latour, it is the only winery in Chablis to make a crémant of Burgundy with chardonnay and pinot noir grapes. This expression's fine bubbles mingle with a balanced palate that's both fresh and powerful, at a fraction of the price of its champagne counterpart.
